Pursuant to the legal provisions of Annex 18 ICAO and the associated Technical Instructions and article 16 "Transport of Dangerous Goods" of the Swiss Air Transport Regulations (LTrV), transport of the above item is permitted only under certain circumstances due to the potential hazard posed to the safety of passengers and/or the aircraft. Carrying such items in carry-on or checked luggage is permitted with the consent of the air carrier if and only if the power source has been completely disconnected or isolated (the battery has been removed or heat-generating component has been isolated). When removing batteries they must be protected against short-circuiting. The power source may not be restored for the duration of air travel.
